**The Future and Safety of Nuclear Energy  
in the United States – A Briefing  
by Dr. Gregory Jaczko, former Chair  
US Nuclear Regulatory Commission**

The ST&E Committee of the NH House and the E&NR Committee of the NH Senate announces a special briefing by Dr. Gregory Jaczko, former Chair of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), entitled “The Future of Nuclear Energy and Safety Issues in the United States”. This briefing will take place in Concord, NH in Rooms 302-304 of the LOB, on Sept. 12 from 2 to 4PM, and is open to the public.

Dr. Jaczko, a physicist, served on the NRC from 2005 until 2012 and was its Chairman from 2009 to 2012. His briefing will include sharing his experiences with dealing with the nuclear energy industry and the political environment, as well as his interactions with Japanese regulators during and subsequent to the Fukushima nuclear accident.

In Jan. 2019 he published a book entitled, “Confessions of a Rogue Nuclear Regulator”. He is now an adjunct professor at Princeton University and Georgetown University.
